4. To facilitate the preparation of the Baptism Certificate, please inform the secretariat in advance if you decide to withdraw from the Baptism. Mon to Fri (9am to 6pm) except Public Holidays. Tel: 63865072.
5. The Baptism ceremony does not include the celebration of Mass.

NOTE: All required certificates must be attached at the time of registration. Forms must be filled and returned to the Parish Office at least TWO WEEKS before Baptism.

Qualifications of a God-Parent

According to Church Law, Canon 874, a person who accepts to be a God-Parent must:

1. be appointed by the candidate for baptism, or by the parents or whoever stands in their place, or failing these, by the parish priest or the minister; to be appointed the person must be suitable for this role and have the intention of fulfilling it;
2. be not less than sixteen years of age, unless a different age has been stipulated by the diocesan Bishop, or unless the parish priest or the minister considers that there is a just reason for an exception to be made;
3. be a catholic who has been confirmed and had received the blessed Eucharist, and who lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken;
4. not labour under a canonical penalty, whether imposed or declared;
5. not be either the father or the mother of the person to be baptised.
